Road Safety Information from Leeds City Council



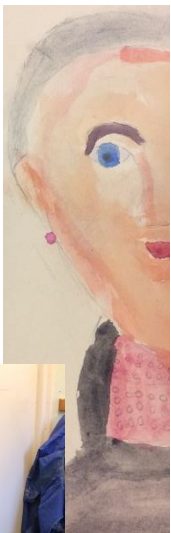
Dear Mr Norris
