Class 1

Class 1 have really enjoyed Reception children staying for lunch this week and we're looking forward to them starting full time on Monday. We all enjoyed watching and singing along to a piano presentation in the hall on Wednesday, led by The Yorkshire Music School and Reception children also enjoyed their first collective worship with Father David. We found a caterpillar on Thursday and we have all helped to take care of it. (We safely released it back into the Hawksworth garden once we had got all the learning opportunities from it that we could!) We enjoyed doing some Great Fire of London Art outside in the sun and have continued to explore materials in Science. Reception have been enjoying some early phonics games and initial sound games, whilst Year One have written lots of sentences, trying to use the days of the week in their work. *Request 1 - please can your child bring in a small shoe box sized box, ready for us to decorate and create our very own Pudding Lane, ready for the fire service visit. Class 2

We have been continuing our learning of the Great Fire of London, finding out what happened and why and how we know about it so many years later. We have looked at the style of a Tudor house and tried to recreate one in a painting. In Maths, we have been re-capping number bonds and using them to work out missing number calculations. In Literacy, we have been reading the story 'How Rabbit Stole the Fire' and learning how to write in 1st person. This week in RE we went on a scavenger hunt around the playground to find a 'precious object'. There were some great finds from unusually shaped sticks to spotty leaves. What was most interesting was reactions when we were asked to swap our find and trust a friend to look after it!! *Mrs S. Oliver*

Class 3

This week Class 3 have put our acting skills to the test by using freeze frames to retell the story of Rama and Sita during our RE lessons. In Maths, we have revised our understanding of place value and used our knowledge of number facts to answer calculations mentally by spotting patterns. We also took on the roles of particles and acted as if we were solids, liquids and gases in Science. It has been fantastic to see the children inspired by Times Tables Rockstars, which is having a positive effect already with children's scores really developing. This week we read the Greek myth 'Daedalus and Icarus' before writing diary entries about the events of the story from Daedalus's point of view. We have continued our Ancient Greece topic by finding out about Greek democracy in History and in Art we have been have been adding colour to our Greek landscape pictures. In Maths, we have been working with decimal numbers and in Science we looked at how animals' physical characteristics help them survive in their habitats. 
