As you will understand the present situation is ever changing. Leeds Catering have now informed schools they will only provide meals for children who are classed as Free School Meals. Income support/Income-based jobseeker's allowance/Income-related employment and support allowance/ National asylum seeker support).

All Hawsworth children attending school next week will need a pack lunch unless they are FSM pupils

Organisation and dispensation of meals

Leeds Catering have split the city into 6 areas and identified 28 'Production and Distribution Hubs' within each area.

Each of the Hubs will be preparing a cold 'Grab Bag' for now. The Grab Bag will include a sandwich, a cake bake, a piece of fruit and a small milk drink. If the meal is for a child who requires a special diet then this will be marked up accordingly. This has been done in consideration of the 14 main allergens.

Each school has been assigned a specific hub, ours is Guiseley Primary School.
