Class 4


All of Class 4 for working so hard on Purple Mash and Century – keep up the good work!

Scarlett's friend waits to taste the cake!






This week Emily made time to get away to the beach and relax with a Cornetto!


This week Max has done some science experiments! Using a vinegar solution to clean copper oxide from pennies to make them look new again and looking at density of different liquids and making a density tower.
