We have had a wonderful week in Class 1. In literacy we have been exploring the story *Funnybones*, sequencing and writing some wonderful sentences about the story. In maths, Year 1 have been learning how to use the greater than and less than symbol. We have all grasped this new concept really quickly and worked independently to solve problems. Well done Year 1. We enjoyed a colour mixing art lesson with Mrs Gallagher on Tuesday. Year 1 learnt about mixing primary colours to create a selection of shades and Reception learnt how to mix 2 primary coloured ice cubes, to make a secondary colour. We are really proud of our Reception children for their first full week at school, they have all been eager to learn, listened so well, followed our rules and routines and settled in just perfectly.

Class 2

This week, Class 2 have been continuing to enjoy their learning about the Great Fire of London. We have started to make city skyline silhouettes in art. In computing, we've been creating Great Fire of London pictures as we learn to log on and off independently. Class 2 have been acting out an escape from the fire and have come up with some brilliant similes describing flames and smoke. In science, we've been using Venn diagrams to classify materials. We've also really enjoyed searching for precious things in nature for RE as we look at Christian creation.

In RE, we discussed the questions 'Why did Jesus touch and heal the leper?' and 'What kind of world did Jesus want?'
