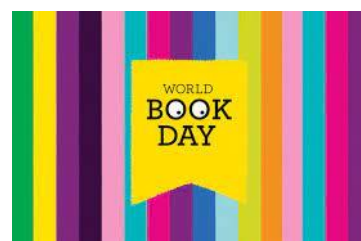
## School News

### Fewston Teas

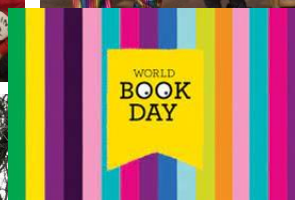

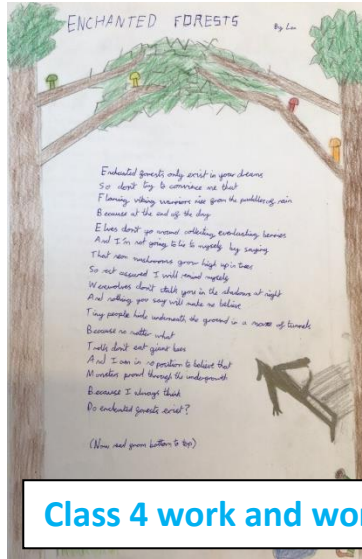
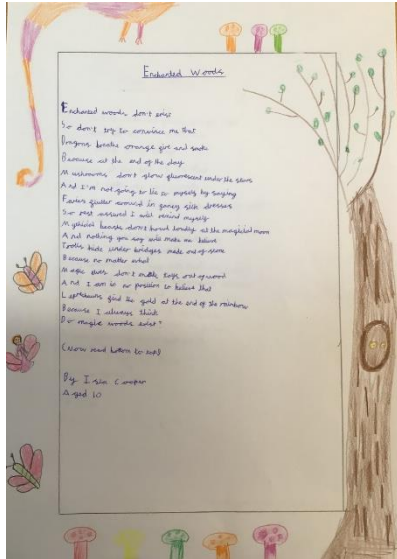
