### Pastoral support

The Department for Education (DfE) offered a grant of £1,200 for eligible state-funded schools and colleges in England to train a Senior Mental Health Lead to develop and implement a whole school or college approach to mental health and wellbeing. This training was not compulsory, but it was part of the government's commitment to offer this training to all eligible schools and colleges by 2025.

I am happy to announce Mrs F. Chalmers-Brown, our School Business Manager, has successfully completed her Senior Mental Health Lead training and has now received her DfE endorsed qualification. Up the Odda returns for 2023 on **Saturday 20th May 2023**. The races are around the trails and woods of Hawksworth and Menston. This is a race for everyone with a 2 lap race but there is also a 1 lap option or our Nuffield Health Duo event for those wanting to race as pairs.

Our junior races were a great success last year, so we have added more options with the 500-metre dash for 5 and 6 year olds, 1 mile for 7 and 8 year olds, 1 mile for 9 -11 year olds plus new for 2023 the Hawksworth Dash for 12-15 year olds which is a 2.5 mile trail race taking in part of the main race including the Odda climb and a finish back at school. The event is in association with Baildon Runners and is sponsored by Vertu Land Rover Guiseley. As always, all proceeds go to Hawksworth C of E Primary School.
